CLINICAL TRIALS:

PRECISE Trial: The purpose of the PRECISE trial is to determine whether overall survival duration, safety, and quality of life are improved for patients treated with IL13-PE38QQR compared to patients treated with GLIADEL® Wafer following surgical tumor removal in the treatment of first recurrence of **Glioblastoma Multiforme**. *I am currently working on this ongoing clinical trial with the Principal Investigator Tom Mikkelsen, MD to gather and collected data to evaluate patients for this clinical trial, 2005.*

PRODIGE Trial: In patients with **Malignant Glioma**, to determine the efficacy of prophylaxis with LMWH (dalteparin) compared to placebo, both commenced beyond the immediate postoperative period, for the prevention of VTE. *I am currently working on this ongoing clinical trial with the Principal Investigator Lisa Rogers, DO to help evaluate patients for this trial, 2005.*

EMD Trial: This study will investigate clinical activity, safety, and tolerability of the anti-angiogenic compound cilengitide (EMD 121974) in the treatment of first recurrence of **Glioblastoma multiforme (GBM)**. *I am currently working on this ongoing clinical trial with the Principal Investigator Tom Mikkelsen, MD to help evaluate patients for this trial, 2005.*

PHARM TM 601-002: This drug is being developed to treat a type of brain cancer, Glioma. This study was developed to evaluate the safety, time to disease progression and survival rates after treatment. *I am currently working with Principal Investigator Tom Mikkelsen, MD to gather and collect data, and to evaluate patients for this trial, 2005.*
